Introduction

Around 2000 people are killed on our roads each year and up to one third of all road accidents and deaths involve someone on company business.

Driver safety whilst driving for business is shifting from personal to corporate responsibility and management can be held vicariously responsible for the actions of their employees. All employers have a duty to provide and maintain a safe place of work. Employers, management and employees need to understand the risks involved in road transport and how they can be controlled.
