



NEBOSH HSE Certificate

in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence



Introduction

The NEBOSH HSE Certificate in Health and Safety Leadership Excellence is a qualification for leaders and aspiring leaders to gain a core understanding of how their behaviours and responsibilities have a direct impact on health and safety management.

Effective leaders understand that health and safety is not just morally important but also helps organisations achieve their objectives, including in finance, operations, compliance and governance.

The syllabus has been developed by NEBOSH in conjunction with the HSE and is based on published HSE guidance.



Course Duration

SSG offer this course over one day as a classroom course. It is a requirement that delegates undertake a minimum of three hours of pre-course study.
