



CITB Director's Role for Health and Safety



Introduction

This interactive CITB course aims to recognise a director's duties of care and the implications of non-compliance with health and safety.

Delegates will be provided with a summary of how to promote a positive organisational culture for health and safety. Group exercises throughout the day will give delegates the opportunity to discuss their thoughts about health and safety and their responsibilities in an open forum.
