In Managing Risks and Risk Assessment at Work



Introduction

The NEBOSH HSE Award in Managing Risks and Risk Assessment at Work is an introductory level qualification jointly developed with the Health and Safety Executive (HSE).

This one-day course is structured around the HSE's approach to controlling the risks caused by workplace hazards. Delegates will develop straightforward, practical health and safety risk management skills so they can go beyond risk assessment to effectively control the health and safety risks caused by hazards in the workplace.



Course Duration

SSG offer this course over one day as a classroom or virtual course.



Course Attendees

This course is suitable for anyone involved in managing workplace health and safety risks, including those who undertake risk assessments. In particular, it would be useful to employers, managers, supervisors, union representatives, SHE champions and health and safety representatives.

Note

The standard of English required by delegates studying this qualification must be such that they can both understand and articulate the concepts contained in the syllabus.
