



# NEBOSH Health and Safety Management for Construction (UK)

(Distance Learning)



## Introduction

Many people take this NEBOSH course as first step in a career in construction health and safety. It provides a valuable overview of construction health and safety issues and is a sound basis for further professional study.

The NEBOSH Health and Safety Management for Construction (UK) replaces the NEBOSH National Certificate in Construction Health and Safety.



## Course Duration

An appropriate time scale for undertaking distance learning is 3-6 months depending on the learning undertaken by the individual; we strongly recommend no longer than 12 months is taken to complete the course. Additional charges of £425 will apply after the 12-month period and new publications may be required.

Distance learners are assigned a tutor who is available to offer guidance and support during the course of study. Delegates will be provided with all course materials including study guidance and appropriate distance learning resources.



## Course Attendees

This course is suitable for managers, supervisors and anyone who manages construction health and safety as part of their duties. It is designed to provide a sound breadth of underpinning knowledge which enables them to carry out their health and safety duties and manage day-to-day risks effectively.

### Note

The standard of English required by delegates studying this qualification must be such that they can both understand and articulate the concepts contained in the syllabus.
