



Managing Scaffold Activities



Introduction

All companies using scaffold have a duty to ensure that it is erected and used in accordance with the statutory requirements and current best practice at all times.

This one-day course will give delegates the knowledge to manage all scaffold activities on site. This course will **not** give the ability to carry out TG20:21 compliant scaffold inspections.



Course Duration

SSG offer this course over one day as a classroom course.
